**Eligibility**

- Either attend Jefferson High School or live within the boundaries of the JNA if attending a high school other than Jefferson (Contact a committee member before applying to verify your residence)
- Be a US citizen.
- Have a GPA of 3.0 (B) or higher
- Acceptance to any school, college or university

**Restrictions**

Awards shall be for tuition, fees and/or books. Applications will be accepted from March 1, 2014 through 6:00 p.m. on May 8, 2014. The scholarship committee reserves the right to screen all applicants and to interview the most outstanding candidates in person before a decision is announced.

**To Apply:**

- Complete the application form (attached or available from committee members)
- Provide proof of GPA
- Provide a copy of acceptance letter to any school, college or university
- Write a letter stating why you should receive a scholarship. Include your immediate objectives and long-range goals. Also include school, church or volunteer activities.
- Submit one letter of recommendation from teachers, religious leader, volunteer advisors or community leaders.

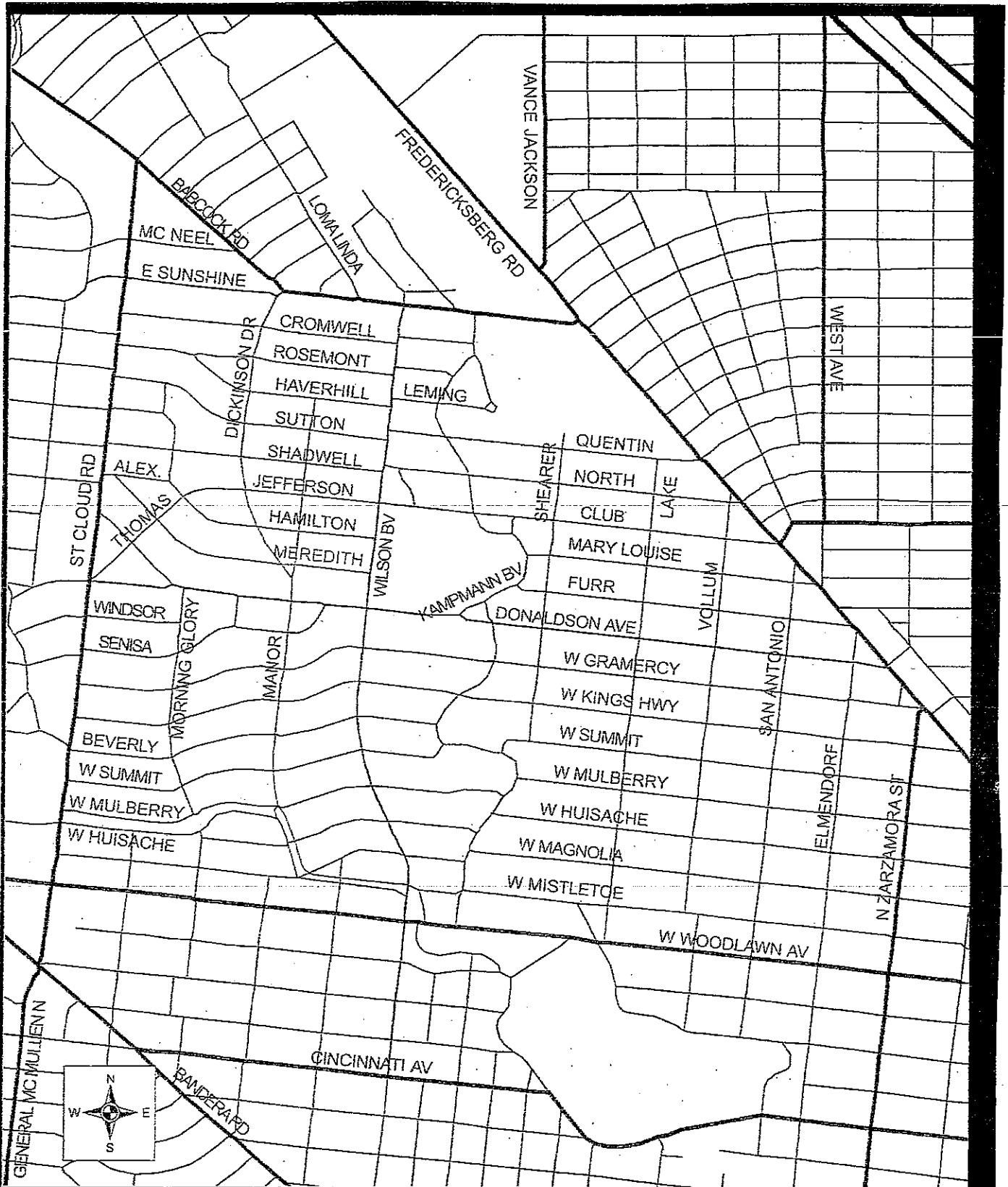
